WHEREAS, Adam married his wife Janet Pickett on February 14, 1995; and

WHEREAS, on October 6, 1995 Adam became a proud father for the second time to a son Adam Dalton, Jr. (AJ for short); and

WHEREAS, Adam became Vice Tribal Chairman in 2005 and Tribal Chairman on January 20, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Adam is considered a true visionary and since his election has worked tirelessly to restore four local parks and ball fields to date, with the promise of eventually repairing all parks within Amador County with the ongoing support of volunteers; and

WHEREAS, Adam immediately initiated relief efforts and quickly opened the doors to any and all evacuees affected by the Butte Fire tragedy transforming the hotel into a Red Cross emergency shelter which together with the Tribe, offered assistance to the many terrified victims; and

WHEREAS, Adam compels others with his vision and drive to touch the lives of others, particularly those who are less able to help themselves.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California, that said Board does hereby honor and recognize Adam Wayne Dalton as the 2015 Amador County Peace Officers' Association Citizen of the Year.
