WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors finds it necessary to protect the economy and environment of Amador County from the impacts of the exportation of groundwater out of the county; and

WHEREAS, Amador County Code currently does not specifically address the circumstances under which the extraction and export of groundwater may occur or the requirements for such use; and

WHEREAS, the Amador County Board of Supervisors wishes to consider amending Title 19 (Zoning) of the Amador County Code to establish regulations relating to the extraction and export of groundwater.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California, does hereby adopt a Resolution of Intention to initiate proceedings to amend Title 19 (Zoning), to include regulations pertaining to the extraction and export of groundwater.
