WHEREAS, Pat was reclassified to the Drinking Driver Program Assistant, on October 1, 1991; and

WHEREAS, on November 1, 1995, Pat took on the position of Alcohol/Drug & Health Education Program Assistant; and

WHEREAS, Pat promoted to Alcohol and Drug Counselor I on July 1, 1997; and

WHEREAS, As a source of additional income for the Alcohol and Drug Department, Pat ran the DUI program, working late nights in order to allow working clients the ability to complete their program; and

WHEREAS, Pat promoted on September 1, 2000 to Alcohol and Drug Counselor II; and

WHEREAS, On February 1, 2003 to Alcohol and Drug Counselor III; and

WHEREAS, As times changed, the Alcohol and Drug Department and the Mental Health Department merged to become the Behavioral Health Department, at this time Pat became a Behavioral Health Care Counselor II on July 1, 2005; and

WHEREAS, The Behavioral Health Department moved into a new building December 2007, and on March 1, 2008 Pat promoted to the Behavioral Health Care Supervisor for Alcohol and Drug services; and

WHEREAS, Pat worked for over 25 years for Amador County and provided Alcohol and Drug services that she believed in, and made a difference in many people's lives.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California, that said Board does hereby recognize and congratulate Pat Bartosiewicz for her dedication to the Behavioral Health Department and the citizens of Amador County.
