WHEREAS, when Alice was six months old her family relocated to New York Ranch Road near Jackson where her father was the caretaker of the George Thomas Ranch; and

WHEREAS, Alice attended local schools, eventually graduating from Jackson High School in 1931; and

WHEREAS, Alice was awarded the McGee Scholarship from Jackson High School and attended “Teachers Normal” in Berkeley, California and later returned to Amador County to begin her teaching career; and

WHEREAS, Alice taught her first classes in a one room school house in Jackson, California known as New York Ranch School; and

WHEREAS, Alice met her husband Ralph DuFrene at a New Year’s Eve Dance in Jackson, California; and

WHEREAS, the couple were married in 1936 and made their home on a ranch near what is now known as Lake Camanche and were blessed with two sons, Mark and Pat; and

WHEREAS, Alice continued her teaching career in Ione providing guidance and love to generations of children until her retirement in 1976; and

WHEREAS, Alice was passionate about teaching and loved the children and the families as if they were her own.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California, that said Board does hereby honor and recognize Alice Jane DuFrene for her commitment to the community and to the Ione Grange.
