WHEREAS, Michael E. Ryan, Amador County Tax Collector, has filed a verified application for discharge from accountability for the collection of taxes, penalties and interest, and any other charges pertaining thereto, for various delinquent unsecured tax bills where amounts are so small as to not justify the cost of collection or collection enforcement is impractical (Revenue and Taxation Code Section 2923); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of Amador County is satisfied that the matters contained in the application are true and correct and the amounts shown are such as to not justify the cost of collection or collection enforcement is impractical; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Tax Collector Michael E. Ryan is hereby discharged from further accountability for the collection of the amounts specified in the attached application and the Board of Supervisors of Amador County hereby authorizes Mr. Ryan to close his books in regard to these items, and further, that such discharge does not release any person from the payment of any amounts which are due and owing upon which a Certificate of Lien has been filed; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Amador County Auditor is authorized and directed to make the proper entries in the books of account to accomplish the intent of the foregoing Resolution.
