WHEREAS, Amador County Code Chapter 19.32.010 N adopted on January 10, 2012 and Amador County Code Section 19.32.010 H adopted on April 24, 2012 provide for temporary off-site directional signs and additional on-site banners for Amador County businesses in times of economic need as defined in Amador County Code Section 19.32.010 N.3; and

WHEREAS, to date, the Amador County sales and use tax revenue is seven hundred and sixty nine thousand dollars (\$769,000) for fiscal year 2011-2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California, does hereby adopt this resolution declaring an economic need pursuant to Amador County Code Chapter 19.32.010 N.3. and 19.32.010 H.2. This declaration of economic need is valid until April 24, 2014.
