WHEREAS, at this time, all existing signalized intersections in the County have been equipped with system and are now operational; and

WHEREAS, the County of Amador, is concerned that potential operational and safety concerns might arise if future signalization projects are not designed and equipped with this system.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the County of Amador, State of California, hereby directs that all future signalization projects within its jurisdiction should be designed and constructed to include this system.
