WHEREAS, Audrey and Mervin H. Sheppard were married on October 4, 1941 and after the war, Mervin became Sutter Creeks' Postmaster for over 25 years; and

WHEREAS, Audrey and Mervin spent countless hours improving the ancestral home and its grounds and gardens which Audrey continues to enjoy today; and

WHEREAS, Audrey and Mervin were married for sixty-five happy years until his passing in 2006
