BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California, that, pursuant to said Government Code Section 6157(b), each County Department, and any other entity that receives and deposits checks into the Amador County Treasury, is authorized to charge and shall collect the sum of \$75.00 for each check which is returned without payment, for the purpose of recovering the County's processing and collection costs relating to such returned check.
