WHEREAS the California Legislature passed and the Governor signed legislation allowing assessors to post changes in the assessed value of real and personal property (“value notices”) on County websites to inform each assessee of their property’s change in value; and

WHEREAS, California Revenue and Taxation Code Section 621 requires that in order to provide value notices on a County website, assessors must first obtain the approval of the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the electronic method of providing value notices is cost effective; and


WHEREAS, for persons without internet access, the assessor will provide alternative means of providing value notices; and

WHEREAS, all property owners receive value notice information as part of the regular property tax mailing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Amador County Assessor is herewith authorized effective January 1, 2011 to provide value notices to assessees of real and personal property by posting the value notice on the county website.
