WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. 1688, abolishing the office of county road commissioner of Amador County and transferred all duties of the road commissioner to the Director of Transportation and Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors officially hired Aaron Brusatori, as Community Development Director on May 1, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Community Development Director will also serve as the Director of Transportation and Public Works; and

WHEREAS, Section 2006.1 of the Streets and Highway Code of the State of California gives the Board of Supervisors the authority to appoint a county director of transportation if the office of road commissioner has been abolished and all duties of the road commissioner are transferred to the director of public works.




