WHEREAS, Section 987.5 of the California Penal Code sets forth a procedure for assessing a registration fee to be paid by defendants represented by court-appointed counsel and the Amador County Board of Supervisors authorized the collection of this fee in Resolution No. 08-110; and

WHEREAS, Section 1205 subdivision (d) of the California Penal Code authorizes the collection of fees for the processing of accounts, whether paid in installments or not.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California, that said Board does hereby elect to:

- 1. Eliminate the registration fee in the amount of \$25.00 to be paid by defendants represented by court-appointed counsel, pursuant to Penal Code Section 987.5 and instead, pursuant to the MOU for Collection Services between the County of Amador and Superior Court, Amador County, charge the first hour of attorney time, or any portion thereof, at \$25.00, such fee to be collected by the agency responsible for collection of Court Ordered Debt as designated by the County and to be paid to the County for reimbursement of court-appointed counsel services.
- 2. Authorize the collection of a \$35.00 fee to be paid by defendants to the clerk of the court or the collecting agency for the processing of installment accounts.
- 3. Authorize the collection of a \$30.00 fee to be paid by defendants to the clerk of the court or the collecting agency for the processing of accounts receivable that are not to be paid in installments.
