WHEREAS, The Environmental Health Department is the Certified Unified Program Agency (CUPA) for Amador County as authorized under California Health and Safety Code section 25404; and

WHEREAS, California Health and Safety Code section 25404.2(a)(3) requires that the CUPA develop and implement a single, unified inspection and enforcement program to ensure coordinated, efficient, and effective regulation of hazardous materials and hazardous waste; and

WHEREAS, the Hazardous Materials Advisory Committee in cooperation with CUPA staff have developed an inspection and enforcement plan that is intended to achieve compliance with a minimum of impact on the regulated community; and

WHEREAS, the Inspection Plan is education based with the goal of achieving compliance through the education of hazardous materials handlers on the requirements of the program by identifying additional activities such as industry specific workshops and newsletters to further the education of the regulated community; and

WHEREAS, the Enforcement Plan provides for a graduated enforcement policy allowing an easy return to compliance for minor violations, includes a standardized matrix establishing criteria for the evaluation of significant violations in a fair and consistent manner, and a procedure for the appeal of CUPA enforcement actions.

NOW, THEREFOR, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California that said Board approves the Amador County Unified Program Inspection and Enforcement Plans, as revised on May 27, 2010 by the Hazardous Materials Advisory Committee.


