WHEREAS, John L. Ouilhon Jr. was born on April 7, 1954 in Burlingame, California to John and Beverly Ouilhon; and

WHEREAS, John graduated from Serra High School in San Mateo, California in 1973; and

WHEREAS, John attended the College of San Mateo; and

WHEREAS, John was hired as a State Humane Officer for San Mateo County in 1977, promoting to Chief in Charge of the State Humane Officers for San Mateo County in 1979; and

WHEREAS, John married his beautiful wife Victoria "Joey" on September 8, 1979; and

WHEREAS, John began his Law Enforcement career as a Police Officer with the City of San Mateo in March 1981, and soon thereafter began the Santa Rosa Criminal Justice Police Academy in April 1981; and

WHEREAS, John was assigned to the Patrol Division in June 1981 to 1985, where he supervised the Reserve Police Officer Program, the Cadet Police Officer Program and coordinated undercover Alcohol and Tobacco Sting Operations; and

WHEREAS, John, Joey and their daughter Megan moved to Amador County in 1985, followed by the birth of their son, Joseph in 1986; and

WHEREAS, John began his service with the Amador County Sheriff's Office on May 20, 1985, assigned to the Patrol Division; and

WHEREAS, John attended Field Training Officer School, Boating Operator School, Sexual Assault Investigation, Death Investigation, Child Abuse Investigation and various other specialized training courses throughout his career; and

WHEREAS, John served as President, Vice-President and Secretary of the Amador County Deputy Sheriff's Association (ACDSA); and

WHEREAS, John promoted to Sergeant in April 1992, assigned to the Patrol Division, where he served as the Canine Supervisor and Cadet Coordinator; and

WHEREAS, John was assigned to the Investigations Bureau on October 1, 1997, specializing in the Investigation of Crimes Against Persons and Death Investigations; and

WHEREAS, John also supervised the Crime Specific Unit (CSU) in 1997 and served as Liaison to the Amador County Secret Witness Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, John was assigned to the Coroner Division and has remained in that position through June 30, 2010; and

WHEREAS, John has been instrumental in coordinating and conducting numerous training classes relative to Coroner Law for medical staff at Sutter Amador Hospital, Kit Carson Rehabilitation Center as well as Hospice of Amador; and

WHEREAS, John has been an active member in the Jackson Lion's Club, served on various committee's in the California State Coroner's Association (CSCA) and a past member of the Amador County Peace Officer's Association; and

WHEREAS, John exemplified the Sheriff's Core Values of Service, Integrity, Teamwork and Excellence (S.I.T.E.) throughout his career at the Amador County Sheriff's Office; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, State of California, that said Board does hereby adopt this resolution commending John L. Ouilhon Jr. for his many years of service to the people of the County of Amador.
