NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman, Board of Supervisors, or his designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the County of Amador all grant documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments and requests for payment, necessary to secure grant funds and implement the approved grant project.
