WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 45 (Blakeslee) authorizes counties to adopt an ordinance providing for the installation of small wind energy systems which establishes a process and standards for the issuance of conditional use permits for these systems;

WHEREAS, counties will be subject to the provisions of Assembly Bill 45 (Blakeslee) in regards to the installation of small wind energy systems if a local ordinance is not adopted prior to January 1, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Amador County Board of Supervisors wishes to develop local regulations amending Title 19 (Zoning) of the Amador County Code to include regulations pertaining to the installation of small wind energy systems.


