**SUBJECT:** 2024 Proposed Rate Adjustment/Fuel Surcharge Request

### **BACKGROUND:**

ACES Waste Services, Inc. entered into a new franchise agreement with Amador County effective June 23, 2020, with a term of fifteen (15) years. As provided in the Agreement, the Company has requested a Rate Review for purposes of setting rates effective January 1, 2024, per Section 12.5 of the Agreement following the procedures as set forth in Attachment G to the Agreement. Under the terms of the Agreement the Company's target profit level was reduced from an 87.5% operating ratio to a 90% operating ratio, which equates to a target profit level of 11.1% on allowable expenses.

Concurrent with the new Agreement, the County and the Company also entered into a new operating contract for the County's Buena Vista Transfer Station, also referred to as the Western Amador Recycling Facility (WARF). The term of that Contract is also for fifteen (15) years, in alignment with the term of the Agreement.

The Western Area Recycling Facility (WARF) and Pine Grove Transfer Station (PGTS) are subject to the same rate setting calculations as the Rate Service Areas. Any rate increases at these facilities and for additional services requested by residential and commercial customers must be approved by the Board of Supervisors prior to their effective date.

### **2024 INDEX ADJUSTMENT:**

Staff engaged R3 Consulting Group Inc. (R3) to work on the Annual Rate Adjustment application. The final report of the indexed adjustment for ACES Waste Services, Inc. (Report included in Attachment A).

The attached report from William Schoen of R3 Consulting Group Inc. outlines the indexed rate adjustment for 2024. The report lists the overall recommended rate adjustments for the WARF, PGTS, and requested services by Franchise Area (Rate Zone).

The WARF, PGTS, and area-specific adjustments are as follows:

Franchise Area 2	4.89%

Pine Grove Transfer Station (PGTS)	1.19%
Buena Vista Transfer Station (WARF)	5.71%

The attached report from William Schoen of R3 Consulting Group Inc. outlines the indexed Special Rate Review Adjustment (Fuel Surcharge) for 2023 is to be removed in the upcoming rate year. The rate adjustments above incorporate that reduction. There is no fuel surcharge included for the 2024 rate year.

The new rate schedules and schedules for requested services by rate area are *included as* attachment B to this report. In accordance with the new transfer station agreement, these rates will become effective on January 1, 2024. The rate increases by service area will become effective on January 1, 2024. These increases fall within the annual range anticipated in the five year Proposition 218 authorization passed in the September 13, 2022 Public Hearing.

### **RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

- 1. Approve 2024 Transfer Station Rate Adjustments.
- 2. Approve the 2024 Solid Waste rate increase for Rate Zones 1-4 in accordance with the Proposition 218 provisions adopted in the Public Hearing on September 13, 2022 and direct staff to mail notices to affected customers/property owners with a postmark no later than October 31, 2023.

Dear Mr. Gardner:

Amador County (County) engaged R3 Consulting Group, Inc. (R3) to assist with a review of ACES Waste Services (ACES) Rate Adjustment Request (Rate Application) for rates effective January 1, 2024. This letter report presents the results of our review.

### **Objectives**

To review ACES:

- 2024 Refuse rate Index (RRI) rate adjustment calculations for each of its three (3) County franchise areas, and two (2) transfer stations;<sup>1</sup>
- Fuel Surcharge requested rate adjustment; and
- Provide recommended rate adjustments.

### Background

### **Annual Rate Adjustment**

The County negotiated a 15 year franchise agreement (Agreement) with ACES that was approved by the County Board of Supervisors on June 23, 2020. The rate adjustment mechanism in that Agreement involves annual adjustments to the rates using the established Refuse Rate Index (RRI). Both the County and ACES also have the option of requesting a Detailed Rate Review following the procedures in the Agreement at a frequency of no more than once every three calendar years. The last Detailed Rate Review set the rates for 2022. As such, the soonest the next Detailed Review can occur would be next year; for purposes of setting the rates effective January 1, 2025.

### Last Year's Fuel Surcharge Adjustment

In addition to the annual rate adjustment mechanisms described above, the Agreement also allows for the County or ACES to request a Special Rate Review. ACES requested a Special Rate Review for a fuel surcharge, as part of the prior year's RRI. That fuel surcharge was approved, with the associated rate adjustments shown in the **Table 1**. For purposes of this year's RRI, that fuel surcharge needs to be removed from the rates.

For purposes of setting rates, Franchise Area 4 has historically been combined with Franchise Area 3 with the calculated rate adjustment percentage applied to the applicable Franchise Area 3 and Franchise Area 4 rate schedules.

### Requested Rate Adjustments

### Transfer Station Rate Adjustment Approach

The County's prior Proposition 218 Notice set the maximum increase to the annual rate adjustment for each of the franchise areas at 10% for January 1, 2024 through January 1, 2027. In order to put in place a rate adjustment of more than 10% the County would need to issue a new Proposition 218 Notice and hold a corresponding hearing. If ACES were to have included all allowable 2024 RRI adjustments to the transfer station rates the rate increases in Franchise Areas 1 and 3 & 4 would exceed that 10% maximum. With that understanding, ACES reported that "...in an effort to keep all of the proposed adjustments under the value established on the multi-year 218 notice, we have elected to capture only the change to account for the County of Sacramento Kiefer Landfill expense increase in the new transfer station rates." ACES Original Application only provided for the change in the Kiefer Landfill increase in its RRI calculations for the Pine Grove and Buena Vista transfer stations.

### **Annual Rate Adjustment**

ACES submitted its original 2024 Refuse Rate Index Rate Application (Original Application) to the County on June 9, 2023. That Application calculated the rate adjustments shown in **Table 2** below, effective January 1, 2024. Based on our review and discussions with ACES the adjustment for the fuel surcharge listed in the original Application were revised to fully remove the associated rate impact. With the submittal of its Updated Application (**Attachment 1**), in addition to the fuel surcharge adjustment, ACES also included the allowable RRI adjustments for Labor, Vehicle Maintenance, All Other, and Depreciation and Interest in its Buena Vista Transfer Station RRI calculation. It did not include its allowable adjustment for Diesel Fuel. No changes were made to the Pine Grove Transfer Station RRI calculation in ACES Updated Application, with those rates only increased by the allowable Disposal RRI. The Updated Application calculated RRI rate adjustments are also provided in **Table 2**.<sup>2</sup>

ACES adjustments to the Pine Grove and Buena Vista Transfer Station rates are based on the calculated RRI adjustments, with the resulting calculated rates rounded down to the nearest \$0.25. As such, the actual percentage transfer station rate adjustments are typically less than the calculated RRI percentages.

### Findings / Recommendation

Our review confirmed the accuracy of ACES' "Updated" RRI rate adjustments shown in **Table 2** above. As such, we recommend those adjustment be approved and applied to the rates effective January 1, 2024.
