AMADOR COUNTY ELECTIONS

Resolution of the City Council of the City of Amador City ordering a ballot measure that proposes a quarter cent sales tax for the period of ten years to be submitted for inclusion on the March 5, 2024, Presidential Primary Election

Whereas, on August 17, 2022, the California Transportation Commission did adopt 2022 Local Partnership Formulaic Program Guidelines as authorized by the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017, (Senate Bill [SB] 1, Beall, Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017). (See Exhibit A.); and

Whereas, the purpose of the Local Partnership Formulaic Program is to allocate funds appropriated annually to local or regional Taxing Authorities, of which Amador City is one, that have sought and received voter approval of taxes or that have imposed fees that are dedicated solely for transportation improvements; and

Whereas, the Local Partnership Formulaic Program shall allocate a minimum of \$200,000 per year to each regional or local Taxing Authority that passes a voter approved tax or fee; and

Whereas, to receive Local Partnership Formulaic funding, Taxing Authorities must pass and enact a voter-approved tax or fee, which can be sales tax equal to or greater than one quarter cent, in effect for a minimum period of ten years, and dedicated solely to transportation; and

Whereas, the Local Partnership Formulaic Program is a reimbursable program and requires Taxing Authorities to demonstrate the allocation of 25% matching funds; and

Whereas, in February 2023, Amador City did identify improvements to local roads the cost of which totals \$3.252 million. (See Exhibit B.); and

Whereas, Amador City does not generate sufficient revenue to undertake aforementioned improvements to local roads; and

Whereas, City Council's may initiate a ballot measure by passing a resolution; and

Whereas, proposed ballot measures, including the wording of ballot question, an impartial analysis and approved resolution, must be submitted to Amador County Elections Department on or before November 17, 2023, for inclusion on the March 5, 2024, Presidential Primary Election ballot (See Exhibit C); and

Therefore, be it resolved that the City Council of the Amador City shall submit a ballot measure proposing a quarter cent sales tax for the period of ten years for the sole purpose of transportation improvements and in anticipation of being allocated \$200,000 per year through the California Department of Transportation's Local Partnership Formulaic Program for the same period of ten years; and

Therefore, be it further resolved that the ballot measure language shall read as follows: "For the sole purpose of transportation improvements in Amador City, and to qualify for funding from the California Department of Transportation's Local Partnership Formulaic Program, shall the measure adopting a quarter of a cent sales tax for a period of ten years be adopted in Amador City?"; and

Therefore, be it further resolved that should this resolution pass and subsequently be approved by voters, staff is authorized to annually update and prioritize the list of projects to improve efficiency and mitigate impending crises should they arise.
