NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that if an argument in favor of and an argument against the measure are submitted, copies will be mailed to the respective authors in order that they may submit a rebuttal argument not to exceed two hundred fifty (250) words. Rebuttal arguments must be filed not later than 4:30 p.m. on **December 11, 2023**, and must also be accompanied by a Statement of Accuracy, signed and dated by the author(s).
