Vote Centers are open for 8 hours each day prior to Election Day



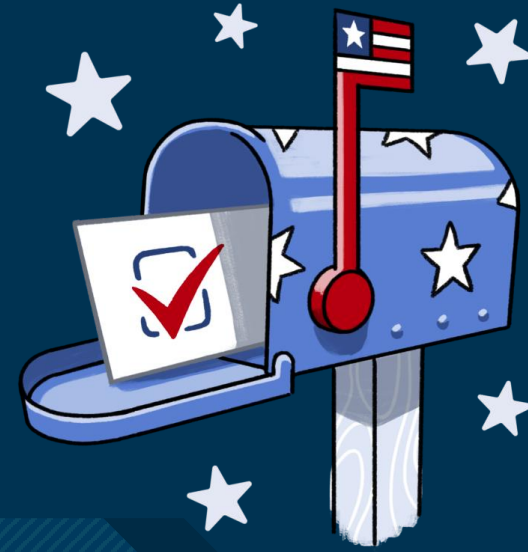
**March 5, 2024**

# Voting in California



## CALIFORNIA VOTER'S CHOICE ACT

### What is a Top 2 Primary?

A Top 2 Primary lets you vote for any candidate (for most races), even if you are not in the same political party. The top 2 candidates – the ones who get the most votes in the primary – will be on the General Election ballot in November.

### Do all offices follow the Top 2 rules?

No. Top 2 applies to these voter-nominated offices:  
United States Senator  
United States Representative  
State Senator  
Member of State Assembly  
Statewide constitutional offices

**Top 2 does not apply to  
elections for  
President  
or  
Party Central Committees**

# United States Senator



There are two U.S. Senate contests on the March 5, 2024, Presidential Primary Election ballot.

The first contest is the regular election for the full 6-year term ending January 3, 2031.

The second contest is a special vacancy election (the current officeholder is temporarily filling a vacancy) for the remainder of the current term ending January 3, 2025.

**You may vote for both contests.**

# Crossover Voting

If you are a No Party Preference voter, you will receive a nonpartisan ballot with no presidential candidates unless you request a party's ballot.

As a voter registered with No Party Preference, your vote-by-mail ballot will not have presidential candidates. If you want to vote for U.S. President, you must request a primary election ballot with presidential candidates from one of the following parties:

Democratic Party

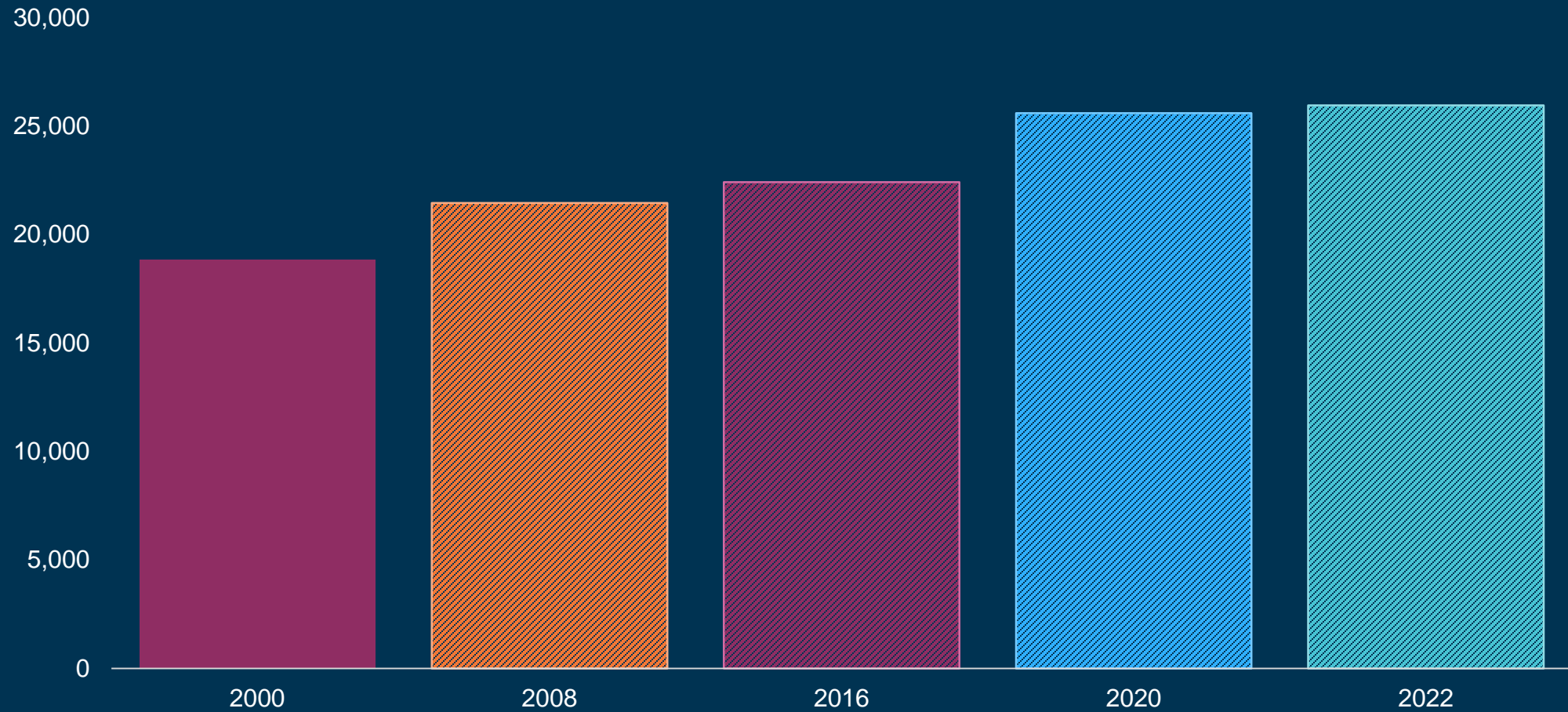
American Independent Party

Libertarian Party
