WHEREAS, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) collects and annually allocates Rule 20A credits to agencies to convert overhead electrical facilities to underground facilities within an approved Underground Utility District

WHEREAS, the County has accumulated \$92,891 in PG&E rule credits and does not have an active or planned project to underground overhead utilities; and

WHEREAS, PG&E’s Rule 20A credit program allows agencies to trade or gift, sell unencumbered Rule 20A credits to other agencies based on a mutually agreeable rate of exchange and an agreement between the agencies for the trade, gift, or sale of such credits; and

WHEREAS, the City of Plymouth is requesting a gift of the credits from the County to support their planned utility undergrounding projects.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, that said Board does hereby authorize the County Administrative Officer to complete the transfer of accumulated PG&E Rule 20A credits.
