WHEREAS, the update of the County's Emergency Operations Plan is to ensure compliance with state and federal guidelines; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador, that said Board does hereby approve the Amador County Emergency Operations Plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of said Board be and hereby is authorized to sign the Letter of Promulgation on behalf of the County of Amador.
