In summary, she noted Amador County issued a Request for Qualification (RFQ) in October 2020 to develop a permanent supportive housing project funded by NPLH, and selected Danco Communities as the County's NPLH Development Sponsor in January 2021. Danco will be financially responsible for the NPLS loan which is ultimately issued by HCD to fund the project.
