We will discuss the MINIMUM safety aspects for the proposed land use plan. Then look at real world consideration to protect the airport and aviation safety for pilots to survive a failed engine in takeoff.

Take a look at Eagles Nest as an ideal long term airport land use protection plan!

The first photo shows the 4,000-foot runway and a paved safety overrun, taxiway up to the road crossing. We have avigation easements on over 450 acres northeast of the airport.

The second photo shows an 83-acre parcel that was in bankruptcy and our owners association purchased that parcel. That is a 2,300-foot safety overrun.

We have an avigation easement on the adjoining 80-acre parcel beyond the hard compacted dirt overrun.
