Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The County of Amador is initiating zone changes for properties which have a zoning district classification that is inconsistent with the land use designation adopted with the 2016 General Plan Land Use Element update. The parcels affected by this request are currently zoned X, Special Use. This change aligns with the County's General Plan and aims to ensure consistency and compliance with state and local regulations. The changes include 142 parcels within District 1, to be rezoned from the X, Special Use zoning district to the R1A, Single-family Residential and Agricultural zoning district.

Reasons why project is exempt:

This project is categorically exempt from CEQA per 15183(a): "CEQA mandates that projects which are consistent with the development density established by existing zoning, community plan, or general plan policies for which an EIR was certified shall not require additional environmental review, except as might be necessary to examine whether there are project-specific significant effects which are peculiar to the project or its site. This streamlines the review of such projects and reduces the need to prepare repetitive environmental studies." Additionally, the zone change is consistent with Government Code Section 65860, which requires that zoning ordinances shall be consistent with the General Plan. Government Code Section 65860(c) states: "in the event that a zoning ordinance becomes inconsistent with a general plan by reason of amendment to the plan, or to any element of the plan, the zoning ordinance shall be amended within a reasonable time so that it is consistent with the general plan as amended." Lastly, this project is not subject to CEQA pursuant to Section 15061(b)3 of the CEQA Guidelines in that the project is covered by the general rule that CEQA only applies to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment.
