



Notice to the Voters of the City of Plymouth (CP22)

For Immediate Release

When an error on the ballot in the voter instructions for the City of Plymouth City Council full term race was noticed, the correction to the wording was completed and a 2nd ballot was mailed to the 758 voters of Consolidated Precinct 22 in the City of Plymouth.

Since that time, we have received approximately 75 ballots from the first mailing. They have been segregated so that voters are given the opportunity to use the 2nd ballot, with the correct instructions, if they choose.

THIS IS TO GIVE NOTICE: If the Elections Office does not receive the 2nd ballot by the eligible deadline for ballots, those that have been received will be counted.

ELIGIBLE DEADLINES FOR BALLOTS:

- 8:00 pm on November 5, 2024 for in person voting at a Vote Center
- 8:00 pm on November 5, 2024 drop a ballot in a drop box at a Vote Center or the drop box at the rear of the County Administration Building or the drop boxes at Lone Plaza Market & Pine Grove Market
- 7:00 pm on November 5, 2024 drop a ballot in a drop box at Pokerville Market (Plymouth) or Youngs IGA Market (Pioneer)
- Postmarked by November 5, 2024 and received by the Elections Office by 4:30 pm on November 12, 2024
