2. Homeless Resource Fair Summary

Tyx Pulkamp and Trixxie Smith provided the group a recap of the Homeless Resource Fair (HRF) that occurred the weekend prior to today's meeting.

- There were ~50 people on Sunday and ~24 people on Monday
- A formal debrief meeting will be held next Thursday
- 21 haircuts were provided
- Todd Pickens was giving eye exams at the Scout Hut on Sunday
- DMV was on site making ID's at the Scout Hut
 - Can use ID for medical, food stamps, etc.
- Area 12 did intake of 33 person digitally then had to switch to paper
- Hep C and COVID vaccines were provided
- \$1,000 donation from Anthem, American Legion Ambulance
- Haircut stylists were given stipends for their work
- James Burke (ACBH) several people received BH services
- Lesley Mace (ATCAA) said ATCAA provided 60 new towels to over 20 people
- Joann Murphy from St. Vincent de Paul 50 individual's laundry vouchers. Helped a man acquire special boots for a fire fighting job

3. Discussion on the 10 Year Plan to End Homelessness

Housing Tools – James Coles and Angel Macias

- James and Angel began discussing the 10 Year Plan to End Homelessness
- The facilitators divided the 10 year plan into 1-2 year and 3-5 year categories with 6 priority areas and goals
- In the 1-2 year regime they brought up the Danco Project and discussed its current status
- The facilitators brought forward various ideas/projects for the group to consider for the 3-5 year regime:
 - Establish housing coalition
 - Address zoning options for RVs and trailers
 - Education and awareness
 - Invite City and County Planning staff to Task Force meetings
 - Participate in Housing Elements
 - Partner with CalTrans on trash pick-up and encampment clean-ups
 - Pallet Shelter option – Benita Asher

- Invite Real Estate managers and organize a meetings with land lord and property managers
- Explore funding a lease guarantee
