Noni Plasichuk & Kristopher Kuntz – Anthem

- Department of Health Care Services (DHCS)
 - o 2 year incentive program from DHCS, managed comp plan (MCP)
 - o Each MCP eligible to earn allocation based on PIT count
 - o 50% of funds are currently allocated and 50% more in March
 - Utilize a corrdinated entry system- homelss management information system (HMIS)
 - o MCPs invested \$285,436 HHIP funds
- Street Medicine
 - o Priority medicine for HHIP program and DHCS
- CalAIM
 - Medi-cal managed care benefit and non-clinical needs, high cost individuals through the coordination of services and comprehensive care management
 - o People experiencing homelessness are a target population for ECM services
