- John gave a brief overview of SVdP and the charitable activities they provide in the communities in which they operate.

- Located on Franklin & MLK
- 14.4 acres
- 125 units
- Building actual homes – not tiny homes
- Cost to build is roughly \$50M and SVdP will be contributing 10% of \$5M
- Accessing “Housing is Key” funding
- The project is called “Hope Haven”
