

## POOL/SPA DAILY MAINTENANCE LOG

CA Code of Regulations, title 22, section 65523:

(a) The pool operator of every public pool open for use at a public pool site shall test the disinfectant residual and pH of the public pool water a minimum of once per day. The pool operator shall maintain a written daily record of all test results, equipment readings, calibrations, and corrective action taken at the public pool site.

(b) If cyanuric acid (stabilizer) is added to the pool, the concentration shall be measured a minimum of once per month and records shall be kept of the results.

(c) The pool operator shall maintain data and records collected for at least two years for inspection by the enforcing agent.
