POOL/SPA DAILY MAINTENANCE LOG

CA Code of Regulations, title 22, section 65523:

- (a) The pool operator of every public pool open for use at a public pool site shall test the disinfectant residual and pH of the public pool water a minimum of once per day. The pool operator shall maintain a written daily record of all test results, equipment readings, calibrations, and corrective action taken at the public pool site.
- (b) If cyanuric acid (stabilizer) is added to the pool, the concentration shall be measured a minimum of once per month and records shall be kept of the results.
- (c) The pool operator shall maintain data and records collected for at least two years for inspection by the enforcing agent.
