PRESS RELEASE

The Amador County Board of Supervisors today announced that the Buena Vista Rancheria of Me-Wuk Indians of California and the County have agreed on a thirty (30) day extension to continue their discussions regarding the proposed gaming and entertainment facility to be located on the east side of Coal Mine Road, in the unincorporated area of Amador County near what is commonly known as Buena Vista in the Jackson Valley. The initial deadline for negotiations was July 11, 2007; however, as part of this agreed upon extension of time, the parties have until August 10 to reach a draft agreement and the Board must consider any draft agreement by August 28, 2007.
