

ORDINANCE NO. 1699

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Sub-section 2.04.090.B of Chapter 2.04 of the Amador County Code shall be deleted and the following revised Sub-section 2.04.090.B shall be adopted and substituted in place of the deleted sub-section:

“2.04.090 Salaries and benefits.

...

B. Effective July 1, 2012, each supervisor for the county shall receive as compensation for services required of him/her by law or by virtue of his/her office an amount equal to forty percent of the Amador County superior court judge’s monthly pay in effect on June 30, 2011, for each month during which such supervisor holds office. Such salary shall be prorated for the first and last month of his/her term. Each year thereafter, the board of supervisors’ annual rate of compensation shall be adjusted on July 1st without further direction to the auditor-controller or personnel department, to an amount that is forty percent of the Amador County superior court judge’s salary in effect on July 1st of the same year.

SECTION 2. This ordinance or a summary thereof shall be published within fifteen days after the date hereof in a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of Amador, State of California, and shall become effective sixty days after the date hereof.

The foregoing ordinance was duly passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Amador at a regular meeting thereof, held on the 19th day of October 2010, by the following vote:


